Elect Progressive Leaders

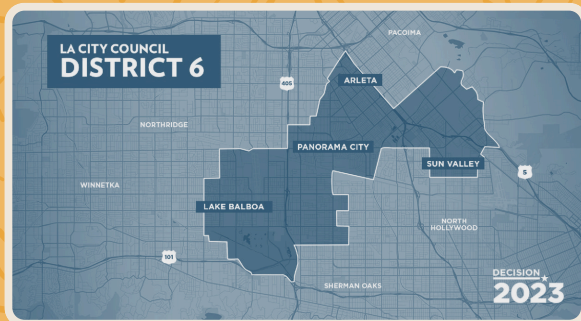
Progressive leaders understand their communities' needs and prioritize California's families over corporations.



Defeated the recall of Santa Ana City Councilmember Jessie Lopez with 56% of the vote



Elected Monica Montgomery Steppe as the first Black woman on the San Diego Board of Supervisors with 62% of the vote



Covered and turned out voters for the LA City Council District 6 special election



Co-hosted U.S. Senate candidate forum featuring Congressional members Barbara Lee, Katie Porter, and Adam Schiff with NUHW



Pass Progressive Policies

Our progressive policy wins from 2023 keep our state moving forward.



Lobbied for 27 California priority bills. 10 passed & signed into law on:

- corporate climate reporting
- fast food worker rights
- social housing
- paid sick leave
- single-payer healthcare



Participated in the Building the California Dream Alliance Lobby Day in Sacramento: 136 reps from 29 orgs met with 58 Assembly Democrats in support of 3 bills on eviction protections, public safety, and paid sick leave.



Two state constitutional amendments qualified for the November 5, 2024 ballot: ACA 5 marriage equality & ACA 13 protect majority votes

Actions taken by our Courage California members

- 26K people called on Congress to tax the wealthy
- 24K people called on federal leadership to investigate Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas' gifts from wealthy donors
- \$24K raised for Amazon Drivers Fund & to hold Amazon accountable for exploiting workers
- \$19K raised for billboards with UltraViolet calling out Walgreens for not providing abortion pills
- \$15K raised for Maui fire relief efforts
- \$3K raised for ICE hunger strikers

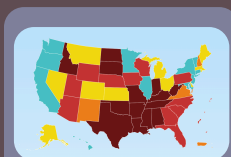
